Minutes of meeting held in the chamber of Secretary (Sports) on 28th May, 2018 to consider the ACTC proposal of "Wushu Association of India" (WAI) for the year 2018-19.

Secretary (Sports) chaired the meeting. DG,DDG, Regional Director(TEAMS), Project Officer (Wushu) and others attended. The following were present from the Wushu Association of India (WAI):-

- 1. Dr. Yogendra Naraian, Chairman
- 2. Shri Bhupender Singh Bajwa, President
- 3. Mr. Suhel Ahmed, General Secretary
- 2. Initiating the discussion, WAI informed that:-
 - The Game of Wushu started in China. In India, it started in 1993.
 - This Game is popular in India in the North East.
 - Normally a Team consists of 13 Wushu players.
 - There are 13 Gold, 13 Silver and 13 Bronze medals at stake in Asian Games.
 - India is strong in "Sanshou" category of Wushu. Therefore, out of 6 Sanshou players, 3-4 medals are expected in Asian Games, one Gold is assured in "Sanshou".
- 3. Thereafter, the meeting took up the ACTC proposal of the WAI for consideration. After due deliberation, the following were approved.

I. National Coaching Camps for senior (Men and Women):-

- In connection with preparation of Wushu players for the up-coming Asian Games, the following coaching camps were approved:-
 - (i) Camp at SAI Bhopal, from 1st April to 30th April, 2018, for 46 campers which had already been approved on file with the approval of the Competent Authority at a total estimated cost of Rs. 28.40 lakh List of names of 46 campers including 5 coaches, 01 Physio is placed at "Annexure-A".

(ii) The meeting noted that already a camp at SAI, HATC, "Shilaru" is in progress up to 31st May, 2018 for 41 campers. On the request of the WAI, it was agreed to extend the camp period up to 15th June, 2018 for 28 campers. It was confirmed that holding camp at "Shilaru" would pose no problem. However, camps had already been approved at the same location from 16th June, 2018 onwards for disciplines like Weightlifting etc.

Hence, camp for 45 days up to 15th June, 2018 at "Shilaru" was approved at a total estimated cost of Rs. 57,74,400/-. Financial support to NSFs for holding camps, would be as per the guidelines of the Scheme of assistance to NSFs.

(iii) WAI informed that during the camp proposed from 16th June to 30th June, 2018 (15 days), selection trials for Asian Games would be held on 29th June, 2018 at SAI, Bhopal. Therefore, holding of this camp was approved in the meeting with a note that after the camps, the selected players would be kept at a location, where weather conditions are similar to Indonesian weather.

WAI on request provided list of names of 37 campers including 5 coaches, 2 Physios, is placed at "Annexure-B". However formal proposal is yet to be received from the WAI for this camp. Financial support would be provided to the WAI, as per Govt. norms.

(iv) Proposal of the WAI to hold the camp for 60 days for 14 campers at SAI, Centre, Bhopal from 1st July, 2018 to 30th August, 2018 was approved in the meeting, as the camp is in preparation of players for the 9th World Cup/ Taijiquan World Wushu Championship/2nd Taolu World Cup. Financial support to the WAI would be as per Govt. norms.

List of names of 14 Wushu players, received from WAIh is placed at "Annexure-C".

Note: - in the ACTC proposal, WAI informed that the camp would be for 24 campers. However, they have provided 14 names only. Therefore, financial support to WAI would be restricted, keeping in view the numbers of campers as 14 only.

(v) Camps proposed for Sep., -Nov., 2018 and Dec., 18'- March, 2019 would be considered after Asian Games. WAI would submit a separate ACTC proposal in this regard.

II. International competitions for senior (Men and Women):-

 Participation of Wushu players along with one coach and one support staff inthe invitational tournament of 2018 Shanghai Cooperation Organization

International Wushu SANDA from 16th to 19th May, 2018 was approved at a total estimated cost of Rs.4,53,800/-only.

- List of names of 7 players, 1 coach and 1 support staff is placed at "Annexure-D".
- WAI informed that the liability of the Govt. towards participation of 12 Wushu players, 2 Coaches (one Sanshou and the other Taolu), 1 Physio and 2 Technical Judges in 7th PARS Cup, Iran from 22nd to 26th June, would be limited only to air passage of the Team. Organizers would meet the boarding and lodging of the entire Team. Participation of Technical Judges in such tournament is mandatory. Earlier also, they were attending such tournaments. Therefore, participation of the entire Indian Team for the 7th PARS Cup was approved.
- Foreign exposure of the team for participation in the 9th SANDA World Cup in China was not considered, as venue and date for the tournament was not yet known.
- Participation of 12 players, (8 Sanshou & 4 Taolu) 2 coaches and 1 International Judge in the 3rd World Taijiquan Championship (Taolu) in Bulgaria from 26th to 30th Sep., 2018 was approved. However, WAI would submit a separate proposal in respect of International Judge.
- Participation of 10 international judges' in India, in "International Judges Course" in Malaysia from 13th to 20th June, 2018 was approved. However, they would not get any Out of Pocket Allowance. WAI would bear this expenditure. The estimated expenditure for 10 judges would be Rs.13,00,000/-.

Normally, the expenditure on International Judges Course is booked under HRD Scheme. However, due to paucity of time, it was decided that the expenditure would be incurred under ACTC; subsequently, the amount incurred would be got reimbursed from HRD Scheme.

- The foreign exposure proposed by the WAI for Myanmar would be considered after Asian Games. WAI would submit separately a revised ACTC proposal after Asian Games.
- The proposal of the WAI for training in China (in World University) from 15th May to 15th June, 2018, approved on file by the Competent Authority, at a total estimated cost of Rs.11,79,240/- was ratified in the ACTC meeting.

• Proposal of the WAI for training of 13 players from 1st July to 10th August, 2018 was considered; WAI informed that the University would provide World class training for our Wushu players. However, the meeting decided to restrict the number of players from 13 to 10 (9 TOPS players + 1 non-TOPS player) and the total period to 30 days only, prior to Asian Games.

Accordingly, for training in China, only 10 players for 30 days prior to Asian Games was approved. Consequently, the estimated cost proposed by WAI would be re-cast, applying the guidelines of Govt., as per the Scheme of Assistance to NSFs.

III. Coaches:-

- A panel of Coaches submitted by WAI as part of ACTC was approved, as the WAI confirmed that:-
 - All the Coaches including the Chief Coach were appointed after following due recruitment process; and
 - Periodically, their performance is being reviewed from time to time.

Mr. Sachidananda from Manipur is a private coach assisting the WAI. WAI informed that Mr. Sachidananda is a SAI approved coach getting a monthly remuneration of Rs. 50,000/-. The meeting noted the position.

IV. Foreign Coaches:-

 WAI informed that no foreign coach was necessary at present; because China having more coaching experts, would provide their services for 2-3 months only.

V. Supporting staff for seniors:-

 WAI was urged to have their own support staff for camps and for accompanying teams for competitions/training abroad.

- WAI should identify suitable support staff and forward their details to SAI for holding interviews etc., before WAI offers them contractual appointment. The support staff so selected should assist the entire team of players. Their monthly remuneration would be as per Govt. norms.
- The support staff so selected would be kept for one year upto Asian Games only. Dietician would be paid on daily basis during the camp period.
- The meeting noted that one Physio is already with the TOPS athletes in China.

VI. Sports Equipment:-

- The meeting noted that camps would be held at Bhopal upto Asian Games. Sports equipment already available with the Bhopal Centre, could be made use of for probables for Asian Games.
- SAI would also review the requirement of additional sports equipment, wherever necessary.
- WAI was therefore, advised to meet their requirements with the sport equipment available at Bhopal Gentre; if additional, requirement becomes essential, that may be submitted separately for consideration.

VII. National Coaching Camps for junior/sub-junior/cadet/youth (Boys and Girls):-

Coaching camps proposed for purpose of preparation for 7th Junior World Wushu Championship being held at SAI Bhopal from 15th May to 16th June, 2018 and proposed to be held from 21st June to 7th July, 2018 were considered. WAI informed that players for camps were selected after conducting open trials for which publicity was given through advertisement; and it was also uploaded on the WAI website.

Therefore, the two camps proposed were approved in the meeting. However, other camps proposed for youth development were not approved, as there are no domestic and international competitions to be held, before Dec., 2018. WAI, however was advised to formulate strategy for conduct of youth development programme.

VIII. International training and competition for junior/sub-junior/cadet/youth (Boys and Girls):-

- One international training from 5th to 20th June, 2018 in China and one international competition (Junior World Wushu Championship) from 9th July to 16th July, 2018 in Brazil proposed in the ACTC proposal were approved. List of 23 players, 4 Coaches, 2 Physios and 2 international technical officials (2 international judges) was approved, as it is mandatory. However, financial support to WAI for these two exposures, would be released as per Govt. norms.
- List of names of 21 players, 4 Coaches, 1 Physio received from WAI is placed at "Annexure-F".

Note: - in the ACTC proposal, WAI informed that the camp would be for 29 campers. However, they have provided 26 names only. Therefore, financial support to WAI would be restricted, keeping in view the numbers of campers as 26 only.

IX. Supporting staff for juniors:-

• The WAI's request for 1 Physio (Male), 1 Physio (Female) and 2 Masseur was considered in the meeting The meeting accorded 'in 'principle' approval to the request. However, WAI would identify them and their bio-data, agreement etc would be forwarded to SAI for consideration. Further, they would be considered for appointment for one year only on contractual basis. Monthly remuneration would be as per Govt. norms.

X. National Championship for seniors, juniors etc.:-

• Three National Championships have been proposed one each for Seniors in Oct, 2018, for Juniors in Nov., 2018 and Sub-Juniors in Dec., 2018. As National Championships are held by the Federations once in a year to know where they stand in competitions, these are allowed by Govt. regularly. However, financial support to WAI in this regard would be as per the scheme of assistance to NSFs.
