List of members present in the meeting is at the end.


2. Mr. Bhupender Singh Bajwa, President, WAI informed about the activities conducted by WAI during lockdown, such as conduct of online National Championship, online courses, ePathshala etc. wherein maximum players participated in these activities.

3. Thereafter, Mr. Kuldeep Handoo, Wushu Coach, briefly explained the current ranking and performance of the Indian Wushu team at Asian and World level. He also informed the members regarding the Key Result Areas (KRA) and Milestones set for the Indian Wushu team up to 2030, which are given below:



In this connection ED(TEAMS) stated that WAI has not yet submitted the utilization certificates for the 50% advance that is Rs. 26.7 Lakh allocated for equipment procurement in the ACTC 2019-20.






