
Sir,

This is in reference to your proposal regarding financial assistance for foreign exposure. I am directed to convey the approval of the Government for financial assistance under the ANSF scheme towards the Participation of Indian Wushu Team in the 05<sup>th</sup> World Taijiquan Championship 2026 from 23<sup>rd</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> April 2026. **At full cost to the Government.**

1. **01 female coach may be nominated for the said event, and out of 2 Male coaches 1 male coach will recommend by WAI.**
2. As per the provisions scheme, the admissible assistance would be provided for the above-mentioned team members only.
3. Section 9 of FC (R) Act, 1976, provides inter-alia that no Member of a legislature, office bearers of a political party, Judge, Government Servant or employee of any Corporation shall accept any foreign hospitality without prior permission of the Central Government. In case, any team member is covered under the above Act, he/she should obtain the prior permission from Ministry of Home Affairs before his/her departure to **Bulgaria**.
4. Such of the team-members who might be Central Government Servants are to be treated as on duty (which include deputation abroad) in respect of this participation by the Department/Office in which they are employed in terms of Department of Personnel & Training O.M. No. 6/1/85-Estt. (Pay-I) dated 30.1.1989. The Federation should inform their employing Department/Office accordingly.
5. It is requested that High Commission/Embassy of India at **Bulgaria** and organizers of the event may please be informed by fax/email of the travel plans and itinerary of the team for participation in the above event. The team members may be advised to call on the Mission for exchange of view.
6. A **Technical report** on the visit of the team along with its **Performance/Achievement** in the above event may please be sent to this Ministry/SAI within 07 days of the return of the team to India along with some action photographs, if possible.




7. Before departure, a report on dope test of the team members may please be obtained from DG, NADA New Delhi.

8. Travel Sector: **Training Venue or Home town to Bulgaria & Back.** In this regard, it is also requested to book ticket through any of the three travel agents viz. (i) M/s Balmer Lawrie & Company Limited (BLCL), (ii) M/s Ashok Travels and Tours (ATT) and (iii) Indian Railways Catering and Tourism Corporation Ltd. (IRCTC), in terms of Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure's OM No. 19024/03/2021 dated 16<sup>th</sup> June, 2022. Further, the tickets have to be booked immediately on receipt of the sanction.
