Subject: Open Selection Trials for Taolu & Sanda Events to shortlist best-8 & best 4 Probable's for Final Selection Trials of the 20th Asian Games-2026.

Dear Members,

The Wushu Association of India (WAI) is pleased to inform all affiliated State/UT Units that the Open Selection Trials for both Taolu and Sanda events will be conducted at Khelo India Centre, Godwin Public School, Meerut, Uttar Pradesh, from 17th to 18th May 2026, with the objective of shortlisting athletes to be among the Best-8 probable for the Final Selection Trials of the 20th Asian Games 2026.

The Final Selection Trials are scheduled to be held at SKISC, Srinagar, J&K, from 05th to 08th June 2026. The Final Selection Trials shall be conducted strictly in accordance with the Selection Policy of the Wushu Association of India (WAI), as updated on the WAI website, and in compliance with the guidelines issued by MYAS/SAI and the Indian Olympic Association (IOA).

The objective of the Open Selection Trials is to identify and shortlist the best athletes to complete the list of Top-8 ranked athletes in Sanda and Top -4 ranked in Taolu eligible for participation in the Final Selection Trials for the 20th Asian Games 2026.

Event Details

Sanda

Men: 56kg, 60kg, 65kg, 70kg & 75kg

Women: 52kg & 60kg

Taolu

- Changquan (Men/Women)
- Taijiquan & Taijjian (Men/Women)
- Nanquan & Nandao (Women)

- Nanquan & Nangun (Men)
- Daoshu & Gunshu (Men)
- Qiangshu & Jianshu (Women)

Further, it is hereby informed that athletes who secured Top-8 & 4 ranking positions in the last Ranking Tournament in both Sanda and Taolu held at Dehradun are exempted from appearing in the Open Selection Trials and shall be directly eligible to participate in the Final Selection Trials at Srinagar.

It is also pertinent to mention that the Long List of athletes has already been submitted to the Indian Olympic Association (IOA) on the basis of the Ranking Tournaments conducted since 2025. Therefore, in case any new athlete emerges through the Open Selection Trials, his/her participation in the Final Selection Trials and further inclusion shall be subject to approval and acceptance by the IOA for inclusion in the Long List.

All affiliated Units are directed to send only one athlete in each weight category/event along with the following mandatory documents:

1. Medical Fitness Certificate
2. Waiver Liability Form
3. Valid Passport

The reporting schedule and other technical details shall be communicated separately.

This may be treated as most important and circulated among all concerned athletes and officials for strict compliance.
