

1. Section 9 of FC (R) Act, 1976, provides inter - alia that no member of a legislature, office bearer of a political party, judge, Government servant or employee of any corporation shall accept any foreign hospitality without the prior permission of the Central Government. In case, any team member is covered under the above act, he/ she obtains the prior permission from the Ministry of Home Affairs before their departure to **China**
2. As regards foreign exchange required for above participation, is requested to **Wushu Association of India** approach authorized dealers for getting the foreign exchange in view of RBI circular No. 41 A.D (M.A. Series) dated 25.1.97.
3. Such of the team - members who might be Central Government Servants are to be treated as on duty (Which include deputation abroad) in respect of the participation by the Departure / Office in which they are employed in teams of Department Personnel & Training O.M. No. 6/1/85-Est. (Pay-1) dated 30.1.1989 should inform their employing Department/ Office accordingly.
4. It is requested that the Indian High Commission/ Embassy in **China** and organizers of the event may please be informed of the travel plans and itinerary of the delegation for participation in the above event. The team members may be advised to call on the Mission for exchange of views.
5. A report on the visit of the team along with its **performance/achievement** in the above Event may please be sent to TEAMS Division, SAI within 7 days of the return of the team to India along with **some action photographs**, if possible.
6. Before departure of the team **Wushu Association of India** may please have the report of Dope Test of members of the team from NADA, If Necessary

Sir,

Further to Administrative Sanction issued from even File No. SAI/TD/Wushu/FE/2026-27/125717 dated 20.06.2026 on the subject mentioned above. I am directed to convey the financial sanction of Competent Authority, in principle, for the subject Foreign Training, as per following break-up of financial assistance and Terms and Conditions:

**I am directed to convey the sanction of Competent Authority for the payment of:**


1. Participation of Indian Wushu Team in the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO) Championship from 24th June to 29th June 2026 and Foreign Training at China from 30th June to 24th July 2026. with an estimated expenditure of **Rs. 80,75,000/- (Rupees Eighty Lakh Seventy Five Thousand only)**
2. Release of 75% Advance **Rs.60,54,375/- (Rupees Sixty Lakh Fifty Four Thousand Three Hundred and Seventy only)** may be release to W.A.I for making smooth arrangements for the said competition and training.
3. The final settlement will be done on receipt of expenditure **details along with bills/vouchers/invoice submitted by W.A.I within 15 days after the event is over to SAI TEAMS DIVISION.**
4. Booking of Air Tickets (17 members) will be booked by W.A.I through Govt. Authorized agency for Hometown/Delhi - China and back and the payment towards airfare & insurance will be directly released to W.A.I after the receiving the bills/vouchers for the same.
5. The amount sanctioned herein will be drawn by the Drawing & Disbursing Officer, Sports Authority of India on the prescribed bill immediately for disbursing the same to grantee through Electronic Clearing System. This grant is of non-recurring nature.
6. **The grant is subject to the conditions mentioned below:-**
  - i. The grantee shall not divert the grants and entrust execution of the scheme or work concerned to another Institution or Organizations and shall abide by the terms & conditions of the grant. If the grantee fails to utilize the grant, for the purpose for which the same has been sanctioned, the grantee will be required to refund the entire amount of the grant with interest thereon @ 10% per annum.
  - ii. The Expenditure statement along with bills/vouchers duly verified should be submitted within 15 days along with the performance-cum-achievement report in respect of the above event for which the grant has been sanctioned should be forwarded to the **TEAMS Division, Sports Authority of India** within one week of the completion of event.
  - iii. That some photographs of the events, i.e. events, medal winners etc. with sample invitation cards for opening and closing ceremony and copies of newspaper clippings related to the event preferably in National and Regional dailies be sent to this office along with performance-cum-achievement report.
  - iv. That the amount in INR will be subject to the actual rate of Foreign Exchange on the date of payment by the Federation. The difference, if any, in INR will be adjusted.
  - v. There is no reason to believe that the grantee is involved in corrupt practice.
  - vi. That no advertisement of Tobacco and Liquor will be displayed during the event, the breach of which entails the cancellation of grant.

  
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- vii. Amount of grant should be utilized only for the purpose for which it is sanctioned and unspent balance of grant shall be refunded by the grantee immediately after conclusion of the event.
- viii. **The grant is further subject to the conditions laid down in General Financial Rules as amended from time to time.**
- ix. The fact that the program is sponsored by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports/ Sports Authority of India should be prominently highlighted and displayed while inviting people and holding functions/programs/events etc.
- x. When the Sports Authority of India/Government of India/State Government has reasons to believe that the sanctioned money is not being utilized for the approved purposes, the payment of the grant will be stopped. If the reply to the show cause notice is not satisfactory, the earlier grant will be recovered with interest as mentioned in Clause I above.
- xi. The grantee institution or organization should exercise reasonable economy in the working of the approved projects.
- xii. As per GFR-212(1), the accounts of grantee institution or organization shall be opened to inspection by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports/Sports Authority of India and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act, 1971 and Internal Audit of Sports Authority of India, New Delhi, whenever the grantee is called upon to do so.
- xiii. **That the grantee shall execute a bond for the full amount of grant in the prescribed pro-forma (Circulated by SAI) on a non-judicial stamp paper in acceptance of the terms and conditions of the grant duly executed by the authorized signatory of the grantee and two sureties and witnesses with complete permanent addresses.**
7. The above sanction has been issued under the powers delegated to the Director General/Secretary/Executive Director of Sports Authority of India. It is certified that the grant being released is in conformity with the rules and regulations of the scheme as approved by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports.
8. The amount of grant will be debit to the Major Head 49.0500 (Assistance to National Sports Federations) for the Financial Year 2026-27 to **Wushu Association of India** Travel sector from **India (Domestic) to China and back.**
